## Open Appeal

INSPIRED BY A husband's passion for cooking, Claudette Andrew of Westborough Design Center, Inc., set to work creating a culinary escape he could use to prepare dishes for his wife, their guests, and their daughter when she visited from college.

The design is an open-plan concept with plenty of space to move around the room during prep, cooking, and cleanup. Its transitional design is splashed with a few contemporary elements—such as the stainless steel chimney hood, a linear slate and glass backsplash, and the stainless steel apron-front sink—while the pot-filler faucet is more traditional.

The cabinetry is also traditional with its classic beaded inset. There is a sense of warmth in the cabinetry's finishes that makes the open floor plan seem cozy and inviting. The island cabinets feature a weathered and worn finish, while the perimeter cabinetry features a combing effect. A slight sparkle on the island top adds a touch of elegance.

Other interesting features: wood panels disguising the Thermador refrigerator, pull-out spice racks hidden behind decorative posts flanking range, an appliance garage for larger countertop appliances, and tray dividers in the island—all perfect accessories for adding appeal to this open-concept kitchen.
